

Newington Court is a Extra Care housing scheme in the Rother District.

It makes an important contribution towards the community in a rural area by providing supported housing to older people, as well as local employment opportunities.

Facilities and activities include a drop-in surgery and a community cafe.

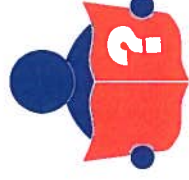
These services are available to the local community as well as residents with the aim of encouraging integration.

Housing management and facilities are provided by AmicusHorizon and housing support is provided by Supporting People. Staffing and care are provided by Care at Home Social Care.

Newington Court, located in Ticehurst, provides Extra Care housing for older people. It includes 35 flats and is owned by AmicusHorizon, a registered social landlord. Care and support services are provided by Care at Home Services.

The scheme has been developed in partnership with:

- **Rother District Council.**

About the care

Care at Newington Court is provided by Care at Home Services, a registered domiciliary care company that can offer a range of care packages.

As well as personal care, support staff can offer practical help with domestic tasks, such as cleaning, meal preparation, laundry and shopping.

Health and well being

Staff work with residents to ensure they receive the right health care and can access health professionals including:

- Doctors
- Dentists
- Opticians
- Chiropodists
- Occupational therapists

About the support

The housing team at Newington Court can also provide assistance with:

1. Claiming benefits
2. Paying bills
3. Managing money
4. Accessing local activities/clubs
5. Arranging appointments
6. Referrals for minor adaptations to the flat

About Extra Care

Extra Care housing is an enhanced form of independent living accommodation with care and support included. It is a very important step towards providing better services and accommodation for older people.

All residents at Newington Court have an assured tenancy and fully self-contained flats. There is 24-hour care provision on site and meals can be provided if required.

The in-house care team is the crucial element of Extra Care. The team can provide personal care to customers living in the scheme who may otherwise need to move into residential care and face losing their independence.

All flats are fitted with the latest technology and alarm monitoring systems.

Communal facilities include:

1. Large lounge
2. Community café
3. Computer access
4. On site surgery
5. Activities room
6. Assisted shower/bathroom
7. Storage for mobility scooters
8. Laundry room
9. Atrium
10. Large garden

How to apply for Newington Court

Care packages may be funded by East Sussex Adult Social Care and assessed by East Sussex Adult Social Care.

To be eligible for referral, applicants must:

- be 60 or over or assessed as requiring the service
- have a housing need
- have clear care and support needs as assessed by East Sussex Social Services
