## **COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY (CIL)**

### **Regulation 62 - CIL Monitoring Report 2016/17**

#### **1.0 Introduction**

- 1.1 The Rother District Council Community Infrastructure levy (CIL) Charging Schedule was approved by Full Council on 14 December 2015 and became effective on 4 April 2016. Planning developments permitted from 4 April 2016 will potentially be liable to pay the Levy as per the schedule of charges.
- 1.2 Regulation 123 of the Community Infrastructure Regulations 2010 (as amended) restricts the use of planning obligations for infrastructure that will be funded in whole or in part by CIL. This is to ensure there is no duplication between CIL and planning obligations secured through Section 106 agreements in funding the same infrastructure projects.
- 1.3 Regulation 62 of the CIL Regulations 2010 (as amended) states:  
  
“A Charging Authority must prepare a report for any financial year (the reported year) in which:
  - a) it collects CIL, or CIL is collected on its behalf: or
  - b) an amount of CIL collected by it or another person on its behalf (whether in the reported year or any other) has not been spent.”
- 1.4 The financial year to which this document relates is 2016/17.
